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
# PART 6

In this part we will be making 32 motifs which are worked in the round and then turned into square motifs.

#### Making your circle outside motifs

Make 32 circle motifs in total; 8 in 1 round each of L, F, K, L 8 in 1 round each of C, E, D, B 8 in 1 round each of E, D, B, C 8 in 1 round each of A, B, C, D

**Round 1:** Using 1st color, make ch4, join with sl st, ch3 (counts as 1dc throughout), work 11dc into circle just made, sl st to top of first ch-3. 12dc



**Round 2:** Change to 2nd color, ch3, work 1dc in same st on which ch-3 sits, 2dc in each dc to end, sl st to top of ch-3. 24dc



**Round 3:** Change to 3rd color, ch3, (2dc in next dc, 1dc in next dc); rep to end, ending 2dc in last dc, sl st to top of ch-3. 36dc



**Round 4:** Change to 4th color, ch3, (2dc in next dc, 1dc in each of next 2dc) rep to end, ending 2dc in next dc, 1dc in last dc, sl st to top of ch-3. 48dc



#### Turn your circle into a square

**Round 5:** Join yarn H for 'My Sun & Stars' and 'My Vintage' and using G for 'My Country Garden' to first st of any 2dc increased in round 4, ch4 (counts as 1tr), (1tr, ch2, 2tr) in same st on which ch-4 sits, \* 1dc in each of next 2dc, 1hdc in each of next 2dc, 1sc in each of next 3dc, 1hdc in each of next 2dc, 1dc in each of next 2dc, (2tr, ch2, 2tr) in next dc, rep from \* 3 times more ending 1dc in next 2dc, sl st to top of ch-4. 17sts per side (including 1 chain from each side of your 2ch sp). Fasten off.



**Tip:** Remember sewing in your ends as you go along will save a lot of sewing in altogether when you have finished your blanket.
