Cablemagoria *Knit Along*

Welcome to Part 4 of the Stylecraft Cablemagoria Blanket Knit Along designed for us by Stuart Hillard. Available in five colourways, the blanket can be made in Special Aran, Highland Heathers Aran and Grace.

Almost there, panel 4 of 5! We will be bringing you the final panel in a fortnight (just 2 weeks time). The last date for your diary is:

6th December.

Part 4 will focus on a Raised Chain on Reverse Stocking Stitch. You will need to make 2 panels using stitches C3L, C3R, C4L, C4R and C5R. Don't worry if you are not familiar with these techniques, they are explained in step-by-step pictures later.

We have set out at the beginning of Part 4 which colour yarn and equipment you will need. We always repeat abbreviations at the beginning of each pattern. The step-by-step images within the pattern have been shown in Ocean, using Special Aran. The completed panels in the other four colourways are shown at the end of the pattern.

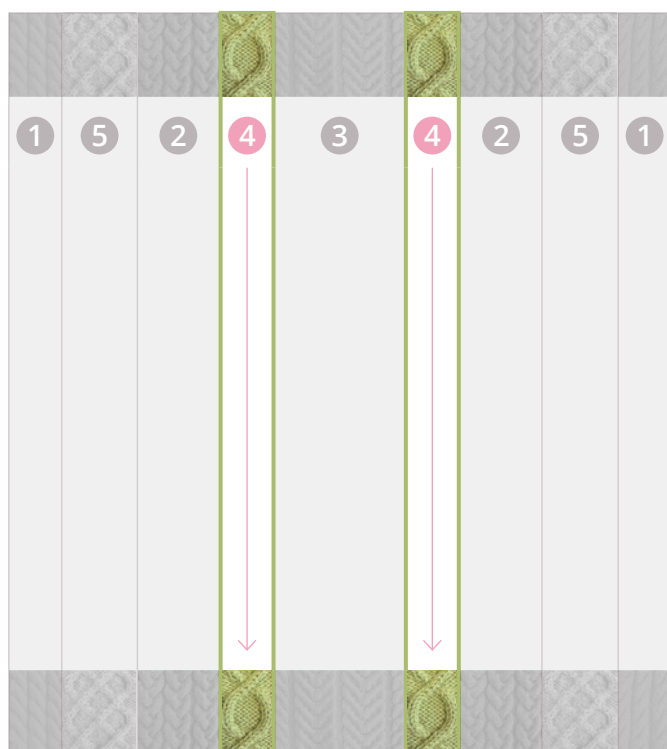
The 5 different panels when joined together create a blanket of the following size depending on the yarn you chose:

Special Aran: Approx width 120cm x length 140cm (47½in x 55in)

Grace: Approx width 114cm x length 140cm (45in x 55in)

Highland Heathers Aran: Approx width 126cm x length 140cm (49¾in x 55in)

- 1 pair of 5mm (UK 6 - USA 8) knitting needles
- Cable needle

Abbreviations

cm centimetre(s); **g** grammes; **in** inch(es); **K** knit; **mm** millimetres; **P** purl; **RS** right side; **st(s)** stitch(es); **WS** wrong side.

Tension

Special Aran:

17 sts measure 9cm (3½in) over panel on 5mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

Grace:

17 sts measure 8cm (3in) over panel on 5mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

Highland Heathers Aran:

17 sts measure 9cm (3½in) over panel on 5mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

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Part Four - Raised Chain on Reverse Stocking Stitch

Cable 4, directly either side of the centre cable, make 2

Raised Chain on Reverse Stocking Stitch

This cable is a lovely clean and classic twist but there's a little more to think about...the knit and purl stitches change position as the cable ropes twist and turn across the surface of your knitting. I've pared this down to a single repeat so take your time and enjoy learning a few new techniques.

Pattern

With 5mm needles cast on 17 sts

Row 1 (RS): K1, P2, K2, P7, K2, P2, K1

Row 2: P1, K2, P2, K7, P2, K2, P1

Row 3: K1, P2, C3L, P5, C3R, P2, K1

Row 4: P1, K3, P2, K5, P2, K3, P1

Row 5: K1, P3, C4L, P1, C4R, P3, K1

Row 6: P1, K5, P2, K1, P2, K5, P1

Row 7: K1, P5, C5R, P5, K1

Row 8: P1, K5, P2, K1, P2, K5, P1

Row 9: K1, P3, C4R, P1, C4L, P3, K1

Row 10: P1, K3, P2, K5, P2, K3, P1

Row 11: K1, P2, C3R, P5, C3L, P2, K1

Row 12: P1, K2, P2, K7, P2, K2, P1

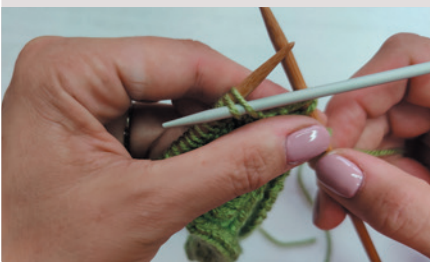
Row 13: K1, P2, K2, P7, K2, P2, K1

Row 14: P1, K2, P2, K7, P2, K2, P1

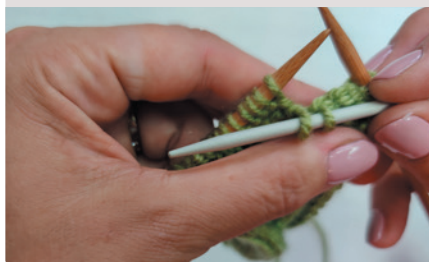
Repeat rows 1-14 until your band measures 140cm (55in) ending with a WS row. Cast off in pattern.

C3L explained... slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, Purl next st then Knit the 2 sts from the cable needle.

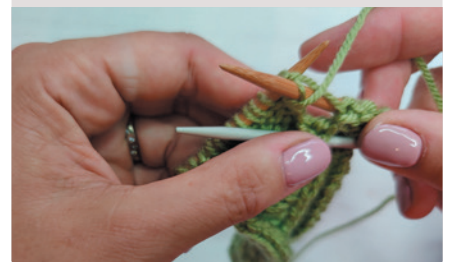
1. Slip 2 sts to cable needle



2. Hold at front



3. Purl next st



4. Knit sts from cable needle



5. Finished cable



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Part Four - Raised Chain on Reverse Stocking Stitch

C3R explained... slip next stitch onto cable needle and hold at back of work, Knit next 2 sts then Purl the st from cable needle.

1. Slip next st onto cable needle



2. Hold at back



3. Knit next 2 sts

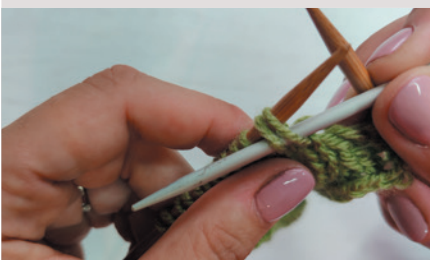


4. Purl sts from cable needle



C4L explained... slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold at front of work, Purl next 2 sts then Knit the 2 sts from cable needle.

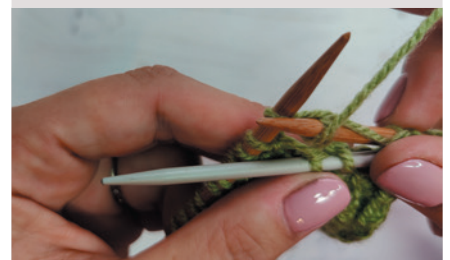
1. Slip 2 sts to cable needle



2. Hold at front



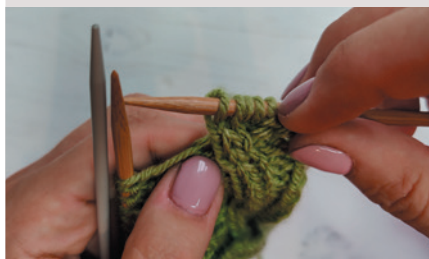
3. Purl next 2 sts



4. Knit sts from cable needle



5. Finished cable



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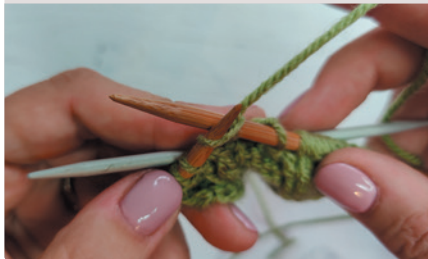
Part Four - Raised Chain on Reverse Stocking Stitch

C4R explained... slip next 2 sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, Knit next 2 sts then Purl the 2 sts from cable needle.

1. Slip next 2 sts to cable needle



2. Knit next 2 sts



3. Purl sts from cable needle

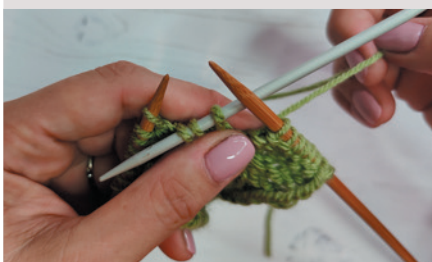


4. Finished cable

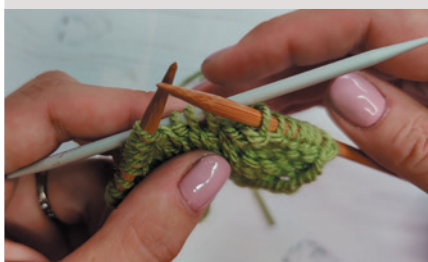


C5R explained... slip next 3 sts onto cable needle and hold at back of work, Knit next 2 sts, replace the 3rd st from the cable needle back onto the left hand needle then bring cable needle to front of work, now Purl the st from left hand needle and Knit the 2 sts from cable needle.

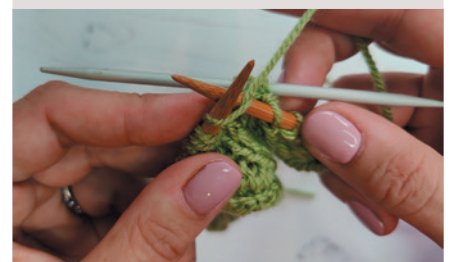
1. Slip next 3sts to cable needle



2. Place cable needle at the back



3. Knit next 2 sts



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Part Four - Raised Chain on Reverse Stocking Stitch

C5R explained...

4. Replace the 3rd st from the cable needle back onto the left hand needle



5. Purl sts



6. Knit 2 sts from cable needle



7. Finished cable
