1 pair 5 mm (UK 6 – USA 8) knitting needles and 1 pair 6 mm (UK 4 – USA 10) knitting needles. Stitch holders. 6 buttons plus 1 button for optional flower trim.

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

TENSION 14 sts and 20 rows to 10 cm, 4 in, over stocking stitch on 6 mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure the correct size of garment and you should always knit a tension square.

If there are less sts and rows to 10 cm, 4 in, change to finer needles if there are more sts and rows to 10 cm, 4 in, change to larger needles.

Instructions are given for the first, smallest size. Larger sizes are given in square brackets. Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes. Where the figure 0 appears, no stitches, times, or rows are worked for this size.

After casting off, one stitch will remain on the right hand needle which is not included in the instructions that follow.

Circle the size you wish to make

BACK

Using 6 mm needles and thumb method cast on
49[57:63:71:79] sts.

1st row. P1[1:0:0:0], * k1, p1, rep from * to last 0[0:1:1:1] st, k0[0:1:1:1].

2nd row. As 1st row.

3rd row. K1[1:0:0:0], * p1, k1, rep from * to last 0[0:1:1:1] st, p0[0:1:1:1].

4th row. As 3rd row.

These 4 rows form Irish moss st. Work in Irish moss st for a further 2 rows, ending with a ws row.

1st row. Knit.

2nd row. Purl.

These 2 rows form st-st.

Cont in st-st until Back measures 24[30:31:31:33] cm, 9½[11¾:12:12:13] in, ending with a ws row.

Shape Armholes

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next 2 rows.
45[53:59:67:75] sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 1[1:3:3:3] rows, then on foll 2[2:1:1:2] alt rows.

39[47:51:59:65] sts.

Cont without shaping until armholes measure 16[18:21:23:25] cm, 6¼[7:8¼:9:9¾] in, ending with a ws row.

Shape Shoulders

Cast off 4[5:5:6:7] sts at beg of next 4 rows, then 3[4:6:7:8] sts at beg of foll 2 rows.

Break yarn and leave rem

17[19:19:21:21] sts on a holder.

LEFT FRONT

Using 6 mm needles and thumb method cast on
30[34:39:43:47] sts.

1st row. P1[1:0:0:0], * k1, p1, rep from * to last st, k1.

2nd row. * K1, p1, rep from * to last 0[0:1:1:1] st, k0[0:1:1:1].

3rd row. K1[1:0:0:0], * p1, k1, rep from * to last st, p1.

4th row. * P1, k1, rep from * to last 0[0:1:1:1] st, p0[0:1:1:1].

These 4 rows form Irish moss st. Work in Irish moss st for a further 2 rows, ending with a ws row.

Next row. K to last 11[11:15:15:15] sts, patt to end.

Next row. Patt 11[11:15:15:15] sts, p to end.

These 2 rows set the sts as follows: front opening edge sts in Irish moss st and all other sts in st-st.

Cont in patt as set until Left Front matches Back to start of armhole shaping, ending with a ws row.

Shape Armhole

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next row. 28[32:37:41:45] sts.

Work 1 row.

Dec 1 st at armhole edge of next 1[1:3:3:3] rows, then on foll 2[2:1:1:2] alt rows. 25[29:33:37:40] sts.

Cont in patt without shaping until 14[16:18:18:20] rows less have been worked than on Back to start of shoulder shaping, ending with a ws row.

Shape Front Neck

Next row. Patt 15[19:22:25:29] sts and turn, leaving rem 10[10:11:12:11] sts on a holder (for Neckband).

Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 2 rows, then on foll 0[1:2:2:3] alt rows, then on 2 foll 4th rows. 11[14:16:19:22] sts.

Work 3 rows, ending with a ws row.

Shape Shoulder

Cast off 4[5:5:6:7] sts at beg of next and foll alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 3[4:6:7:8] sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Using 6 mm needles and thumb method cast on 30[34:39:43:47] sts.

1st row. * K1, p1, rep from * to last 0[0:1:1:1] st, k0[0:1:1:1].

2nd row. P1[1:0:0:0], * k1, p1, rep from * to last st, k1.

3rd row. * P1, k1, rep from * to last 0[0:1:1:1] st, p0[0:1:1:1].

4th row. K1[1:0:0:0], * p1, k1, rep from * to last st, p1.

These 4 rows form Irish moss st. Work in Irish moss st for a further 2 rows, ending with a ws row.

Next row. Patt 11[11:15:15:15] sts, k to end.

Next row. P to last

11[11:15:15:15] sts, patt to end.

These 2 rows set the sts as follows: front opening edge sts in Irish moss st and all other sts in st-st.

Cont in patt as set until Right Front matches Back to start of armhole shaping, ending with a ws row.

Shape Armhole

Work 1 row.

Cast off 2 sts at beg of next row. 28[32:37:41:45] sts.

Dec 1 st at armhole edge of next 1[1:3:3:3] rows, then on foll 1[2:0:1:2] alt rows. 26[29:34:37:40] sts.

Work 1[1:1:3:3] rows, ending with a ws row.

Work first pair of buttonholes as follows:

Next row. Patt 1 st, work 2tog tbl, yrn, patt 4[4:8:8:8] sts, work 2tog tbl, yrn, patt to last 2[0:2:0:0] sts, (k2tog) 1[0:1:0:0] times. 25[29:33:37:40] sts.

Cont in patt without shaping until 16[18:20:20:22] rows less have been worked than on Back to start of shoulder shaping, ending with a ws row.

Work second pair of buttonholes as follows:

Next row. Patt 1 st, work 2tog tbl, yrn, patt 4[4:8:8:8] sts, work 2tog tbl, yrn, patt to end.

Work 1 row.

Shape Front Neck

Next row. Patt 10[10:11:12:11] sts and slip these sts onto a holder (for Neckband), patt to end.

15[19:22:25:29] sts.

Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 2 rows, then on foll 0[1:2:2:3] alt rows, then on 2 foll 4th rows. 11[14:16:19:22] sts.

Work 4 rows, ending with a rs row.

Shape Shoulder

Cast off 4[5:5:6:7] sts at beg of next and foll alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 3[4:6:7:8] sts.

LONG SLEEVES (Both alike)

Using 6 mm needles and thumb method cast on 25[29:29:29:31] sts.

1st row. P1, * k1, p1, rep from * to end.

2nd row. As 1st row.

3rd row. K1, * p1, k1, rep from * to end.

4th row. As 3rd row.

These 4 rows form Irish moss st.

Cont in Irish moss st, shaping sides by inc 1 st at each end of 3rd[5th:3rd:next:next] and foll 0[0:0:6th:4th] row, taking inc sts into patt. 27[31:31:33:35] sts. Work a further 1[1:3:1:3] rows, ending with a ws row.

Starting with a k row, now work in st-st as follows:

Inc 1 st at each end of 5th[7th:3rd:5th:next] and every foll 6th[8th:6th:6th:4th] row until there are 31[47:35:57:43] sts.

For 1st, 3rd and 5th Sizes Only

Inc 1 st at each end of every foll 8th[8th:6th] row until there are 41[51:63] sts.

For All Sizes

Cont without shaping until Sleeve measures 33[41:46:46:47] cm, 13[16:18:18:18½] in, ending with a ws row.

Shape Top

Cast off 2[3:2:3:3] sts at beg of next 2[8:2:10:14] rows, then 3[4:3:4:0] sts at beg of foll 8[2:10:2:0] rows. Cast off rem 13[15:17:19:21] sts.

¾ SLEEVES (Both alike)

Using 6 mm needles and thumb method cast on 29[33:33:35:37] sts.

1st row. P1, * k1, p1, rep from * to end.

2nd row. As 1st row.

3rd row. K1, * p1, k1, rep from * to end.

4th row. As 3rd row.

These 4 rows form Irish moss st. Cont in Irish moss st, shaping sides by inc 1 st at each end of 3rd[3rd:3rd:next:next] and foll 0[0:0:4th:4th] row, taking inc sts into patt. 31[35:35:39:41] sts. Work a further 1[3:3:3:3] rows, ending with a ws row.

Starting with a k row, now work in st-st as follows:

Inc 1 st at each end of 5th[5th:3rd:3rd:next] and every foll 6th[8th:6th:6th:4th] row until there are 35[47:43:57:53] sts.

For 1st, 3rd and 5th Sizes Only

Inc 1 st at each end of every foll 8th[8th:6th] row until there are 41[51:63] sts.

For All Sizes

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Cont without shaping until Sleeve measures 25[32:36:36] cm, 9¾[12½:14:14] in, ending with a ws row.

Shape Top

Cast off 2[3:2:3:3] sts at beg of next 2[8:2:10:14] rows, then 3[4:3:4:0] sts at beg of foll 8[2:10:2:0] rows. Cast off rem 13[15:17:19:21] sts.

NECKBAND

Join both shoulder seams.

With rs of work facing and using 5 mm needles, slip 10[10:11:12:11] sts on right front holder onto right needle, rejoin yarn and pick up and knit 13[15:16:16:17] sts up right side of front neck, k across 17[19:19:21:21] sts on back holder, pick up and knit 13[15:16:16:17] sts down left side of front neck, then k across 10[10:11:12:11] sts on left front holder. 63[69:73:77:77] sts.

Next row. Knit.

Rep last row once more, ending with a **rs** row.

Cast off knitwise (on **ws**).

BELT TAB

Using 6 mm needles and thumb method cast on 17[19:21:21:21] sts.

Starting with a 1st row, work in Irish moss st as given for Sleeves for 6[6:8:8:8] rows, ending with a ws row.

Cast off in patt.

TO MAKE UP

Place a marker at centre of each Sleeve top. Sew Sleeves into armholes, matching markers to shoulder seams. Join side and Sleeve seams. Sew on buttons.

Using photograph as a guide, position Belt Tab on Back and secure in place by attaching a button through both layers at each end of Tab.

Pin out Jacket to the measurements given. Cover with clean, damp tea towels and leave to dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

FLOWER TRIM (Optional)

Using 5 mm needles and thumb method cast on 75 sts, placing a marker after every 15th st – 5 markers in total (including marker after last cast-on st).

Cast off, leaving a long end.

Using this long end, sew through each marked point, pulling up strip to form a flower shape with 5 looped petals. Secure ends, then sew Flower Trim to Right Front as in photograph, attaching a button at centre.



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
