**Fusion Chunky** 100g balls 2

Colour used Heather 1679

Alternative Yarns ReCreate Chunky, Life Chunky, Special Chunky. If using an alternative yarn, please check the meterage as the number of balls needed may vary.

1 pair 6 mm (UK 4 - USA 10) knitting needles. Cable needle for blanket, leaf cushion and leaf and Irish moss stitch cushion. 3 buttons, 3cm, 11/4in for cushion. Cushion pad 46x46cm, 18x18in. Coloured markers.

#### SPECIAL ABBREVIATONS

Irish moss-st. Irish moss -stitch

Row 1 (rs): \* K1, p1, rep from \* to last st, work, k1 then p1 from cn.

Row 2: P1, \* k1, p1, rep from \* to end. Row 3: \* P1, k1, rep from \* to last st, p1. Row 2: Purl. Row 4: K1, \* p1, k1, rep from \* to end. Rep rows 1 to 4.

T2F slip next st onto cn and hold at front Row 1 (rs): Purl. of work, p1 then k1 from cn.

T2B slip next st onto cn and hold at back of

St-st. Stocking stitch

Row 1 (rs): Knit.

Rep rows 1 and 2.

Rev St-st Reverse Stocking stitch

Row 2: Knit Rep rows 1 and 2

M1 make one stitch by picking up the horizontal strand between next two stitches and knitting through back of loop.

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore

**TENSION** See tension at the beginning of each pattern.

It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure the correct size and you should always knit a tension square. If there are less sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to finer needles if there are more sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to larger needles. # LEAF AND IRISH MOSS STITCH CUSHION

Tension: Leaf panel 11 sts measures 9cm, 3½in. 14 sts and 22 rows to 10cm, 4in, over Irish moss stitch on 6mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

Using 6mm needles and thumb method cast on 61 sts. Work 11 rows in Irish moss-st.

**12th row (ws).** K1, (p1, k1) 10 times, k4, (m1, k2) 6 times, k3, (k1, p1) 10 times, k1. 67 sts. Work as follows:

Row 1 (rs): K1, (p1, k1) 10 times, p9, k1, p3, k7, p5, (k1, p1) 10 times, k1.

Row 2: P1, (k1, p1) 10 times, k5, p7, k3, p1, k9, (p1, k1) 10 times,

Row 3: P1, (k1, p1) 10 times, p8, slip next st onto cn and hold at back of work, k1 then k1 from cn. p3, skpo, k5, p5, (p1, k1) 10 times,

Row 4: K1, (p1, k1) 10 times, k5, p6, k3, p2, k8, (k1, p1) 10 times, k1.

**Row 5:** K1, (p1, k1) 10 times, p7, T2B, k1, p3, skpo, k4, p5, (k1, p1) 10 times, k1, 65 sts.

**Row 6:** P1, (k1, p1) 10 times, k5, p5, k3, p1, k1, p1, k7, (p1, k1) 10 times, p1.

Row 7: P1, (k1, p1) 10 times, p6, T2B, p1, k1, p3, skpo, k3, p5, (p1, k1) 10 times, p1. 64 sts.

Row 8: K1, (p1, k1) 10 times, k5, p4, k3, p1, k2, p1, k6, (k1, p1) 10 times, k1.

Row 9: K1, (p1, k1) 10 times, p5, T2B, p2, k1, p3, skpo, k2, p5, (k1, p1) 10 times, k1. 63 sts.

Row 10: P1, (k1, p1) 10 times, k5, p3, (k3, p1) twice, k5, (p1, k1) 10 times, p1.

Row 11: P1, (k1, p1) 10 times, p5, m1, k1, m1, p3, k1, p3, skpo, k1, p5, (p1, k1) 10 times, p1. 64 sts.

Row 12: K1, (p1, k1) 10 times, k5, p2, k3, p1, k3, p3, k5, (k1, p1) 10 times, k1.

Row 13: K1, (p1, k1) 10 times, p5, (k1, m1) twice, (k1, p3) twice, skpo, p5, (k1, p1) 10 times, k1. 65

Row 14: P1, (k1, p1) 10 times, k5, p1, (k3, p1) twice, p4, k5, (p1, k1) 10 times, p1.

**Row 15:** P1, (k1, p1) 10 times, p5, k2, (m1, k1) twice, (k1, p3) twice, p6, (p1, k1) 10 times, p1. 67 sts. **Row 16:** K1, (p1, k1) 10 times, k6, (k3, p1) twice, p6, k5, (k1, p1) 10 times, k1.

**Row 17:** K1, (p1, k1) 10 times, p5, k6, (k1, p3) twice, p6, (k1, p1) 10 times, k1.

**Row 18:** P1, (k1, p1) 10 times, k6, (k3, p1) twice, p6, k5, (p1, k1) 10 times, p1.

Row 19: P1, (k1, p1) 10 times, p5, k5, k2tog, p3, slip next st onto cn and hold at front of work, k1 then k1 from cn, p8, (p1, k1) 10 times, p1. 66 sts.

Row 20: K1, (p1, k1) 10 times, k8, p2, k3, p6, k5, (k1, p1) 10 times, k1.

**Row 21:** K1, (p1, k1) 10 times, p5, k4, k2tog, p3, k1, T2F, p7, (k1, p1) 10 times, k1. 65 sts.

**Row 22:** P1, (k1, p1) 10 times, k7, p1, k1, p1, k3, p5, k5, (p1, k1) 10 times, p1.

**Row 23:** P1, (k1, p1) 10 times, p5, k3, k2tog, p3, k1, p1, T2F, p6, (p1, k1) 10 times, p1. 64 sts.

**Row 24:** K1, (p1, k1) 10 times, k6, p1,

k2, p1, k3, p4, k5, (k1, p1) 10 times, k1.

**Row 25:** K1, (p1, k1) 10 times, p5, k2, k2tog, p3, k1, p2, T2F, p5, (k1, p1) 10 times, k1. 63 sts.

**Row 26:** P1, (k1, p1) 10 times, k5, (p1, k3) twice, p3, k5, (p1, k1) 10 times, p1.

**Row 27:** P1, (k1, p1) 10 times, p5, k1, k2tog, p3, k1, p3, m1, k1, m1, p5, (p1, k1) 10 times, p1. 64 sts. **Row 28:** K1, (p1, k1) 10 times, k5, p3, k3, p1, k3, p2, k5, (k1, p1) 10

times, k1. **Row 29:** K1, (p1, k1) 10 times, p5, k2tog, p3, k1, p3, (k1, m1) twice,

k1, p5, (k1, p1) 10 times, k1. 65

sts. **Row 30:** P1, (k1, p1) 10 times, k5, p5, (k3, p1) twice, k5, (p1, k1) 10

times, p1. **Row 31:** P1, (k1, p1) 10 times, p9, k1, p3, k1, (k1, m1) twice, k2, p5, (p1, k1) 10 times, p1. 67 sts.

**Row 32:** K1, (p1, k1) 10 times, k5, p7, k3, p1, k9, (k1, p1) 10 times, k1

Rows 1 to 32 form **patt**. Cont in patt until cushion measures 24cm, 9½in, ending with a ws row.

Place first coloured markers at each end of last row.

Cont in patt until cushion measures 43cm, 17in, from coloured marker, ending with a ws row.

# Place second coloured markers at each end of last row.

Cont in patt until cushion measures 19cm, 7½in, from second coloured marker, ending after patt row 32 (a ws row).

Next row (rs). K1, (p1, k1) 10 times, (k2, k2tog) 6 times, k1, (k1, p1) 10 times, k1. 61 sts.


Work 5 rows in Irish moss-st.

Next row. Patt 11, patt2tog, yfwd, (patt 16, patt2tog, yfwd) twice, patt 12.

Work 5 rows more in Irish moss-st. Cast off in patt.

### TO MAKE UP

Fold cushion at markers, overlapping first and last 11 rows of Irish moss-st for button border (border will be at centre back of cushion). Join seams. Sew on buttons. Cover with clean damp, tea towels and leave until dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.
