Lace Scarf in Grace

MEASUREMENTS

Approx.

20

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21cm (8¼in) wide x 140cm (55in) long or to desired length

YOU WILL NEED

Grace 100g balls	2 balls	
Colour used	Evergreen 2158	

A pair of 4mm (UK 8 - USA 6) knitting needles, a pair of 5mm (UK 6 - USA 8) knitting needles.

ABBREVIATIONS

approx. approximately cm centimetre(s) cont continue g grammes **in** inch(es)

k knit **mm** millimetre(s) **p** purl patt pattern rs right side

st(s) stitch(es) tog together ws wrong side yfwd yarn forward yrn yarn round needle

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

ssk slip next 2 sts knitwise one at a time, insert left-hand needle into front of slipped sts and knit together.

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

TENSION

21 sts and 24 rows to 10cm, 4in, over lace pattern on 5mm needles or the size required to give the correct tension.

It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure the correct size of garment and you should always knit a tension square.

If there are less sts and rows to 10cm (4in) change to finer needles if there are more sts and rows to 10cm (4in) change to larger needles.

Instructions are given for the first, smallest size. Larger sizes are given in square brackets. Where only one figure is given, this applies to all sizes.

Where the figure 0 appears, no stitches, times, or rows are worked for this size.

SCARF

Using 4mm needles, cast on 44 sts. **Row 1 (rs):** P2, *k1, p2; rep from * to end of row.

Row 2: K2, *p1, k2; rep from * to end of row.

These 2 rows form p2, k1 rib. Cont in rib until work measures 4cm, 1½in, ending with a ws row.

Change to 5mm needles.

Row 1 (rs): P2, k2tog, yrn, p2, (yfwd, k3, ssk, p3, k2tog, k3, yrn, p2, k2tog, yrn, p2) twice.

Row 2: K2, p2, k2, (p5, k3, p5, k2, p2, k2) twice.

Row 3: P2, yfwd, ssk, p2, (k1, yfwd, k2, ssk, p3, k2tog, k2, yfwd, k1, p2, yfwd, ssk, p2) twice.

Row 4: As row 2.

Row 5: P2, k2tog, yrn, p2, (k2, yfwd, k1, ssk, p3, k2tog, k1, yfwd, k2, p2, k2tog, yrn, p2) twice.

Row 6: As row 2.

Row 7: P2, yfwd, ssk, p2, (k3, yfwd, ssk, p3, k2tog, yfwd, k3, p2, yfwd, ssk, p2) twice.

Row 8: As row 2.

Row 9: P2, k2tog, yrn, p2, (k4, yfwd, ssk, p1, k2tog, yfwd, k4, p2, k2tog, yrn, p2) twice.

Row 10: K2, p2, k2, (p6, k1, p6, k2, p2, k2) twice.

Row 11: P2, yfwd, ssk, p2, (k5, yfwd, k3tog, yfwd, k5, p2, yfwd, ssk, p2) twice. Row 12: K2, p2, k2, (p5, k3, p5, k2, p2, k2) twice.

These 12 rows form the lace patt. Cont in patt until scarf measures approx. 136cm (53½in) (or to desired length minus 4cm (11/2in) ending with row 12 of patt.

Change to 4mm needles.

Starting with row 1, work 4cm (11/2in) in p2, k1 rib. Cast off loosely.

TO MAKE UP

Sew in all yarn ends neatly. Pin out scarf to measurements given. Cover with clean damp tea towels and leave to dry. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.



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
