# CABLE EDGE GARTER STITCH SHAWL

## MEASUREMENTS

Shawl 112cm x 71cm  
44in x 28in

(Measured along cast-on edge and perpendicular edge.)

## NEEDLES

1 pair 4mm needles  
(UK 8 – US 6)  
Cable needle

## YOU WILL NEED

2 x 100g balls of Head Over Heels  
75% Superwash Wool, 25% Nylon  
Shawl photographed in Rio Grande  
1166 and New Mexico 1163

## TENSION

24 sts x 44 rows to 10cm over patt  
on 4 mm needles or the size  
required to give the correct  
tension.

## ABBREVIATIONS

**C4F** cable 4sts by putting  
next 2sts on a cable needle  
and leaving at front of  
work, knit the next 2sts  
then knit the 2sts from the  
cable needle  
**cm** centimetre(s)  
**cont** continue  
**fo**ll following  
**g** grammes

**in** inch(es)  
**k** knit  
**mm** millimetre(s)  
**p** purl  
**patt** pattern  
**rem** remain(ing)  
**rep** repeat  
**rs** right side  
**st(s)** stitch(es)  
**tog** together

**ws** wrong side  
**yfwd** yarn forward

## SHAWL

**Colour repeat:** Cast on using Rio Grande  
and cont working in 2 rows of Rio Grande  
and then 2 rows of New Mexico throughout,  
without breaking off the yarn and carry the  
colour yarn not being used along the side of  
the work.

Using 4mm needles cast on 6sts.

**Row 1 (rs):** K2, yfwd, k4. 7sts

**Row 2:** P4, k3.

**Row 3:** K2, yfwd, k5. 8sts

**Row 4:** P4, k4.

**Row 5:** K2, yfwd, k2tog, C4F. 8sts

**Row 6:** P4, k4.

**Row 7:** K2, yfwd, k6. 9sts

**Row 8:** P4, k5.

**Row 9:** K2, yfwd, k7. 10sts

**Row 10:** P4, k6.

**Row 11:** K2, yfwd, k2, k2tog, C4F. 10sts

**Row 12:** P4, k6.

Cont to inc this way every alt row taking  
extra sts into garter stitch and decreasing  
every foll 6<sup>th</sup> row (cable row) as set by row  
11, until 160 sts or you run out of yarn on  
your first ball of yarn, ending rs facing for  
conventional cast off and ws facing for cable  
cast off.

Cast off on a right side row knitwise or work  
a cable cast off (as photographed) as follows:

**Row 1:** (ws): P4, k3tog, turn.

**Row 2:** K1, (K4), turn.

**Row 3:** As row 1.

**Row 4:** as row 2.

**Row 5:** As row 1.

**Row 6:** K1, C4f, turn.

Cont to rep these 6 rows until 5sts rem.  
Cast off.

## FINISHING

Sew in all ends and pin out your shawl cover  
with a damp cloth and leave to dry.
