Crochet Corsages in Cabaret DK

MEASUREMENTS

Corsage Diameter	10cm 4in
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YOU WILL NEED

Plain Corsage

Cabaret DK Pink Bloom (3576)	1 x 100g balls
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Rosette Corsage

Cabaret DK Red Sky (3575)	1 x 100g balls
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Alternative Yarns

Any Stylecraft DK yarn. If using an alternative yarn, please check the meterage as the number of balls needed may vary.

4mm (UK 8 - USA G/6) crochet hook, brooch pin

ABBREVIATIONS

approx approximately	dc double crochet	htr half treble	rep repeat

The yarn amounts stated are based on average requirements and are therefore approximate.

TENSION Motif measures 10cm, 4in, across on 4 mm hook or the size required to give the correct tension.

It is essential to work to the stated tension to ensure the correct size of garment and you should always work a tension square.

If there are less sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to a finer hook if there are more sts and rows to 10cm, 4in, change to a larger hook.

PLAIN CORSAGE

Using 4mm hook make 7ch, join with a sl st into first ch to form a ring.

Round 1: 1ch (does not count as a st throughout), 16dc into ring, sl st into first dc.

Round 2: 1ch, 1dc into first dc, (5ch, miss 1dc, 1dc into next dc) 7 times, 5ch, sl st into first dc. 8 ch sps

Round 3: Sl st into first 5ch sp, 1ch, (1dc, 5htr, 1dc) into each 5ch sp to end, sl st into first dc. 8 petals

Round 4: 1ch, working behind each petal, 1dc into first dc on round 2, (6ch, 1dc into next dc on round 2) 7 times, 6ch, sl st into first dc. 8 ch sps

Round 5: Sl st into first 6ch sp, 1ch, (1dc, 6htr, 1dc) into each 6ch sp to end, sl st into first dc. 8 petals

Round 6: 1ch, working behind each petal, 1dc into first dc on round 4, (7ch, 1dc into next dc on round 4) 7 times, 7ch, sl st into first dc. 8 ch sps

Round 7: Sl st into first 7ch sp, 1ch, (1dc, 7htr, 1dc) into each 7ch sp to end, sl st into first dc. 8 petals

Round 8: 1ch, working behind each petal, 1dc into first dc on round 6, (8ch, 1dc into next dc on round 6) 7 times, 8ch, sl st into first dc. 8 ch sps

Round 9: Sl st into first 8ch sp, 1ch, (1dc, 8htr, 1dc) into each 8ch sp to end, sl st into first dc. 8 petals

Cut yarn and fasten off.

Sew in yarn ends neatly.

TO MAKE UP

Sew a brooch pin securely to the back. See ball band for washing and further care instructions.

ROSETTE CORSAGE

Follow instructions for plain Corsage and continue as follows: Using a 4mm hook make 12ch, work a sl st into 4th ch from hook. Continue like this making chains of various lengths with picots spaced at intervals.

When you have as many picot chains you want, fix to back of corsage securely.

TO WEAR

Attach rosette to hair using hair grips.
